

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the contents of a receipt issued for payment of a good
3 or service; providing a civil penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 501, Business & Commerce
6 Code, as effective April 1, 2009, is amended by adding Section
7 501.1011 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 501.1011. SALES RECEIPT CONTAINING DRIVER'S LICENSE
9 NUMBER PROHIBITED. A person may not print an individual's driver's
10 license number on a receipt that evidences payment for a sale of
11 goods or services and is provided to the individual.

12 SECTION 2. Section 501.102, Business & Commerce Code, as
13 effective April 1, 2009, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and
14 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

15 (a) A person who violates Section 501.101 [~~this subchapter~~]
16 is liable to this state for a civil penalty in an amount not to
17 exceed \$500 for each violation. The attorney general or the
18 prosecuting attorney in the county in which the violation occurs
19 may bring an action to recover the civil penalty imposed under this
20 subsection [~~section~~].

21 (a-1) A person who violates Section 501.1011 is liable to
22 this state for a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$500 for
23 each calendar month in which a violation occurs. The civil penalty
24 may not be imposed for more than one violation that occurs in a

1 month. The attorney general or the prosecuting attorney in the
2 county in which the violation occurs may bring an action to recover
3 the civil penalty imposed under this subsection.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
