

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of certain counties to impose a hotel
3 occupancy tax for the maintenance and operation of a coliseum in the
4 county.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 352.002, Tax Code, is amended by adding
7 Subsection (h) to read as follows:

8 (h) The commissioners court of a county with a population of
9 more than 16,000 that is bordered by Lake J. B. Thomas may impose a
10 tax as provided by Subsection (a).

11 SECTION 2. Section 352.003, Tax Code, is amended by adding
12 Subsection (l) to read as follows:

13 (l) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax
14 under Section 352.002(h) may not exceed two percent of the price
15 paid for a room in a hotel.

16 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Tax Code, is amended
17 by adding Section 352.1036 to read as follows:

18 Sec. 352.1036. USE OF REVENUE: COUNTIES BORDERING LAKE
19 J. B. THOMAS. The revenue from a tax imposed under this chapter by
20 a county authorized to impose the tax under Section 352.002(h) may
21 be used only to operate and maintain a coliseum in the county.

22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
