10 time, she married Leslie Turner, who passed away in 1994; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Daughtrey was employed as a legal secretary
12 with the civil service at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and Camp Campbell,
13 Kentucky, and in the offices of Dick and Brad Hutchison in Paris,
14 Texas, and she was a teacher's aide at Aaron Parker Elementary

17 Baptist Church, she taught Sunday school and served her fellow

1 therefore, be it


2 RESOLVED, That the 81st Legislature of the State of Texas


