

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends are mourning the loss of Roslyn  
2 Davis Sample of Powderly, who died on February 18, 2009, at the age  
3 of 81; and

4           WHEREAS, Roslyn Davis was born on November 11, 1927, to Lloyd  
5 and Evelyn Coursey Davis; she was joined in matrimony to Tom Sample  
6 in 1945, and together they were blessed with a daughter, a  
7 grandchild, three great-grandchildren, and two  
8 great-great-grandchildren; and

9           WHEREAS, Throughout her adult life, Mrs. Sample served her  
10 community as a volunteer, working with the American Red Cross, the  
11 Girl Scouts, the Maxey House, Family Haven, the Retired and Senior  
12 Volunteer Program, and other organizations; she served on the  
13 boards of RSVP and the Northeast Texas Council on Alcohol and Drug  
14 Abuse; and

15           WHEREAS, Mrs. Sample was especially active as a supporter of  
16 Paris Junior College, beginning with her work as an adult education  
17 outreach counselor from 1980 to 1982; starting in 1993, she served  
18 on many committees and projects of the school's Alumni and Friends  
19 Association; she chaired the scholarship endowment fund-raising  
20 luncheon, and she was a longtime member of the college's alumni  
21 board, including three terms as president, from 1996 to 1999; for  
22 her tireless efforts in behalf of the school, she was named a  
23 Distinguished Friend of Paris Junior College in 2002; and

24           WHEREAS, A devoted wife, mother, and grandmother, Roslyn

1 Sample dedicated her life to her family and to the betterment of her  
2 community, and the memory of her energy and her commitment to others  
3 will continue to inspire all who were fortunate enough to know her;  
4 now, therefore, be it

5         RESOLVED, That the 81st Legislature of the State of Texas  
6 hereby pay tribute to the life of Roslyn Davis Sample and extend  
7 sincere condolences to the members of her family: to her husband of  
8 63 years, Tom Sample; to her daughter, Linda Sample Bratcher, and  
9 her husband, Richard; to her granddaughter, Sarah Upchurch; to her  
10 great-grandchildren, Sara Beth Upchurch, Cody Upchurch and his  
11 wife, Mallory, and Charli Gabeline and her husband, Chad; to her  
12 great-great-grandchildren, Gavin Upchurch and Kylar Gabeline; to  
13 her sister, Bille Viehe, and her husband, Mike; to her nephew, Mike
