1 WHEREAS, State employees raised more than \$2.1 million in the
2 2008 Capital Area State Employee Charitable Campaign; and

3 WHEREAS, Despite these challenging economic times, some
4 8,000 state and higher education employees throughout Bastrop,
5 Bell, Blanco, Burnet, Caldwell, Fayette, Hays, Lampasas, Lee,
6 Llano, Mason, San Saba, Travis, and Williamson Counties donated to
7 more than 600 charities statewide; and

8 WHEREAS, Established in 1994, the SECC is the only
9 statutorily authorized workplace charity campaign for state agency
10 and higher education employees in Texas; screened for eligibility,
11 nonprofits that participate in this outstanding program include
12 local, national, and international organizations that provide
13 health and human services to individuals in need; and

14 WHEREAS, Thanks to the generous efforts of those who
15 participated, 2008 marked the fifth consecutive year that the
16 Capital Area SECC has exceeded the amount raised in the previous
17 year, and their contributions have made a positive difference in
18 many lives; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the 81st Legislature of the State of Texas
20 hereby commend the Capital Area State Employee Charitable Campaign
21 on its dedicated efforts in behalf of charities throughout our
22 state and beyond and recognize the many individuals who generously
