2 close on March 28, 2009, with the passing of Manuel Benavidez, Jr.,

3 at the age of 57; and

WHEREAS, A founding member of the board of trustees of South

5 Texas College, Mr. Benavidez was appointed by Governor Ann Richards

6 in 1993 and was twice reelected to represent District 1; through the

7 years, he served the board as chair, vice chair, and secretary, and

8 he further benefited South Texas College as a member of the

9 facilities committee and the education and workforce innovation

10 committee; thanks in part to his dedicated efforts, the institution

11 has grown to serve more than 22,000 students at five campuses; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Benavidez also made notable contributions to

13 area high school students through the creation of the Dual

14 Enrollment Medical Science Academy, which offers juniors and

15 seniors an opportunity to earn an associate's degree in biology

16 tuition-free; a tremendous success, the program has produced many

17 graduates, with the May 2008 class receiving more than \$750,000 in

18 scholarships; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Benavidez's distinguished career included

20 service as director of transportation for the Rio Grande City

21 Consolidated Independent School District; he further shared his

22 time with a number of professional associations, holding leadership

23 roles with the Association of Texas Professional Educators, the

24 South Texas Association for Pupil Transportation, and the Texas

- 1 Association for Pupil Transportation; on the national level, he
- 2 served as representative of the western region for the Association
- 3 of Community College Trustees and was twice elected chair of its
- 4 diversity committee; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Honored for his outstanding work, Mr. Benavidez was
- 6 recognized by ACCT with its Lifetime Membership Award and its
- 7 Western Region Equity Award; moreover, South Texas College named
- 8 the Starr County Campus rural technology center in Mr. Benavidez's
- 9 honor in acknowledgement of the instrumental role he played in the
- 10 creation of that state-of-the-art facility; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The family, friends, and many admirers of Manuel
- 12 Benavidez may take solace in the fact that his was truly a life well
- 13 lived; he was an inspiring and tireless advocate for educational
- 14 opportunities for all, and the positive contributions he made to
- 15 South Texas will resonate for many years to come; now, therefore, be
