4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:


5 SECTION 1. The Lower Concho River Water and Soil

7 this Act, and any assets of the authority escheat to the state in
8 the manner provided by Section 49.327, Water Code.


9 SECTION 2. Chapter 3, page 1053, Special Laws, Acts of the

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.






