- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 504.201, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 8 (3) "Practice of optometry" and "practice of
- 9 therapeutic optometry" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 10 351.002, Occupations Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 504.201, Transportation Code, is amended
- 12 by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 13 follows:
- (d) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), the [The]
- 15 initial application for specialty license plates under this section
- 16 must be accompanied by a written statement from a physician who is
- 17 licensed to practice medicine in this state or in a state adjacent
- 18 to this state or who is authorized by applicable law to practice
- 19 medicine in a hospital or other health facility of the Department of
- 20 Veterans Affairs. If the applicant has a mobility problem caused by
- 21 a disorder of the foot, the written statement may be issued by a
- 22 person licensed to practice podiatry in this state or a state
- 23 adjacent to this state. In this subsection, "podiatry" has the
- 24 meaning assigned by Section 681.001. The statement must certify

- 1 that the person making the application or on whose behalf the
- 2 application is made is legally blind or has a mobility problem that
- 3 substantially impairs the person's ability to ambulate. The
- 4 statement must also certify whether a mobility problem is temporary
- 5 or permanent. A written statement is not required as acceptable
- 6 medical proof if:
- 7 (1) the person with a disability:
- 8 (A) has had a limb, hand, or foot amputated; or
- 9 (B) must use a wheelchair; and
- 10 (2) the applicant and the county assessor-collector
- 11 processing the application execute an affidavit attesting to the
- 12 person's disability.
- 13 <u>(d-1) If the initial application for specialty license</u>
- 14 plates under this section is made by or on behalf of a person who is
- 15 legally blind, the written statement required by Subsection (d) may
- 16 be issued by a person licensed to engage in the practice of
- 17 optometry or the practice of therapeutic optometry in this state or
- 18 <u>a state adjacent to this state.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 681.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 20 by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 21 follows:
- (e) If a first application for a disabled parking placard
- 23 under this section is made by or on behalf of a person with:
- 24 <u>(1)</u> a mobility problem caused by a disorder of the
- 25 foot, the notarized written statement or written prescription
- 26 required by Subsection (c) may be issued by a person licensed to
- 27 practice podiatry in this state or a state adjacent to this state;

1 <u>or</u>

- 2 (2) a disability caused by an impairment of vision as
- 3 provided by Section 681.001(2), the notarized written statement or
- 4 written prescription required by Subsection (c) may be issued by a
- 5 person licensed to engage in the practice of optometry or the
- 6 practice of therapeutic optometry in this state or a state adjacent
- 7 to this state.
- 8 <u>(f) In this section, "practice of optometry" and "practice</u>
- 9 of therapeutic optometry" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 10 351.002, Occupations Code.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 an application for a disabled parking placard or disabled license
- 13 plates submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 14 application submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was
- 16 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
