POWERS RELATING TO DISTRICT PROPERTY, FACILITIES, AND EQUIPMENT. 8 (a) With the approval of the 9 commissioners court, the board may construct, condemn, acquire, 10 lease, add to, maintain, operate, develop, regulate, sell, 11 exchange, and convey any property, property right, equipment, 12 hospital facility, or system to maintain a hospital, building, or 13 other facility or to provide a service required by the district. 14 Approval of the commissioners court shall be required for the sale 15 or lease of a hospital facility regardless of the provisions of Section 285.051. 16 17 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the board may, with the 18 approval of the commissioners court, lease undeveloped real 19 property for not more than 50 years to provide for the development 20 and construction of facilities designed to generate revenue for the financial benefit of the district. The board, directly or through a 21 22 nonprofit corporation, may contract or enter into a joint venture 23 with a public or private entity as necessary to enter into a lease 24 under this subsection.
