SPECIFIC LANGUAGE CONTROLS. A provision of 13 this subtitle that becomes effective on or after January 2, 2010, 14 15 and that requires coverage or the offer of coverage of a health care 16 service or benefit applies to a plan or policy described by Section 17 1425.001(a) only to the extent expressly and specifically provided 18 by law. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
