Not later than December 1, 2010, the commission shall 19 20 submit a report of the results of the study to the legislature. The 21 report must include:

- 26 (2) an analysis of the feasibility of implementing the

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- 1 (e) This Act expires January 1, 2011.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
