- 2 relating to certifying the eligibility of certain educational aides
- 3 to receive an exemption from tuition and fees charged by public
- 4 institutions of higher education.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 54.214, Education Code,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The <u>institution of higher education at which a person</u>
- 9 seeking an exemption under this section is enrolled [coordinating
- 10 board must certify the [a] person's eligibility to receive the
- 11 [an] exemption [under this section]. As soon as practicable after
- 12 receiving an application for certification, the institution
- 13 [coordinating board] shall make the determination of eligibility
- 14 and give notice of its determination to the applicant  $[ \frac{1}{2} ]$
- 15 institution of higher education at which the applicant is
- 16 enrolled, and to the school district employing the applicant
- 17 [person] as an educational aide.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 54.214, Education Code, applies to an exemption from tuition and
- 20 fees granted under that section beginning with the 2009 fall
- 21 semester.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
