

Chapter 841

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the issuance of a citation to an owner of real property  
3 for a violation of a county or municipal rule or ordinance.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 250.003, Local  
6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) An individual who is an employee of the owner of real  
8 property for which a citation for a violation of a county or  
9 municipal rule or ordinance is issued, or of a company that manages  
10 the property on behalf of the property owner, is not personally  
11 liable for criminal or civil penalties resulting from the violation  
12 if, not later than the fifth calendar day after the date the  
13 citation is issued, the individual provides the property owner's  
14 name, current street address, and telephone number to the  
15 enforcement official who issues the citation or the official's  
16 superior.

17 SECTION 2. Section 250.004, Local Government Code, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 250.004. AGENT FOR SERVICE; NOTICE OF CITATION.

20 (a) The [~~If the property owner's street address is not in this~~  
21 ~~state, the~~] employee of the owner or management company to whom a  
22 citation described by Section 250.003 is issued is considered the  
23 owner's agent for accepting service of the citation for the  
24 violation of the county or municipal rule or ordinance. Service of

1 the citation on the agent has the same legal effect as service on  
2 the owner for the purpose of fines against the owner or the  
3 property, including a warrant or capias.

4 (b) The county or municipality issuing the citation shall  
5 mail notice of the citation to the property owner at the address  
6 most recently provided to the county or municipality by the  
7 property owner or by the employee of the owner or management company  
8 under Section 250.003(a). This subsection does not require a  
9 county or municipality to mail notice using a service that provides  
10 delivery confirmation.

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
