6	Sec. 28.0216. DISTRICT GRADING POLICY. A school district
7	shall adopt a grading policy, including provisions for the
8	assignment of grades on class assignments and examinations, before
9	each school year. A district grading policy:
10	(1) must require a classroom teacher to assign a grade
11	that reflects the student's relative mastery of an assignment;
12	(2) may not require a classroom teacher to assign a
13	minimum grade for an assignment without regard to the student's
14	quality of work; and
15	(3) may allow a student a reasonable opportunity to
16	make up or redo a class assignment or examination for which the
17	student received a failing grade.
18	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
19	school year.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
