6	Art. 12.02. MISDEMEANORS. (a) An indictment or
7	information for any Class A or Class B misdemeanor may be presented
8	within two years from the date of the commission of the offense, and
9	not afterward.
10	(b) A complaint or information for any Class C misdemeanor
11	may be presented within two years from the date of the commission of
12	the offense, and not afterward.
13	SECTION 2. The change in law made by Article 12.02, Code of
14	Criminal Procedure, as amended by this Act, does not apply to an
15	offense if the prosecution of that offense became barred by
16	limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution
17	of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
