- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 662.153 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 662.153. MONARCH BUTTERFLY WEEK. (a) The first seven
- 8 days of October are Monarch Butterfly Week to encourage Texas
- 9 residents and visitors to study, observe, and promote the life of
- 10 the state insect, the monarch butterfly.
- (b) Through participation in the Texas Monarch Watch
- 12 program sponsored by the Parks and Wildlife Department, Texas
- 13 residents and visitors may help scientists answer research
- 14 questions about monarch biology and migration.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
