

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 192; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting a limited power of eminent domain.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8330 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 8330. FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 192

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 8330.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "Director" means a board member.

(3) "District" means the Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 192.

Sec. 8330.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 8330.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

Sec. 8330.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. (a) The temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8330.003 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or

1 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has  
2 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the  
3 district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

4 (b) Subject to the limitations of Section 54.016, Water  
5 Code, the district shall comply with all applicable requirements of  
6 any ordinance or resolution adopted by the governing body of the  
7 municipality that consents to the creation of the district or to the  
8 inclusion of lands within the district.

9 (c) In addition to the restrictions and conditions  
10 described by Section 54.016(e), Water Code, a municipality that  
11 contains district territory in its corporate limits or  
12 extraterritorial jurisdiction may include in the municipality's  
13 consent any restriction on or condition to the municipality's  
14 consent to the creation of the district, including a limitation on  
15 the powers of the district otherwise granted by this chapter.

16 Sec. 8330.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT.

17 (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

18 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

19 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by  
20 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

21 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that  
22 relate to the construction, acquisition, or improvement of  
23 macadamized, graveled, or paved roads described by Section 54.234,  
24 Water Code, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of  
25 those roads.

26 Sec. 8330.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The  
27 district is initially composed of the territory described by

1 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

2 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of  
3 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the  
4 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process  
5 does not affect the district's:

6 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

7 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes  
8 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and  
9 interest on a bond;

10 (3) right to impose a tax; or

11 (4) legality or operation.

13 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

14 Sec. 8330.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is  
15 governed by a board of five elected directors.

16 (b) Except as provided by Section 8330.052, directors serve  
17 staggered four-year terms.

18 Sec. 8330.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after the  
19 effective date of the Act creating this chapter, the owner or owners  
20 of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the  
21 district may submit a petition to the Texas Commission on  
22 Environmental Quality requesting that the commission appoint as  
23 temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The  
24 commission shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons  
25 named in the petition.

26 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

27 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under

1 Section 8330.003; or

2 (2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of  
3 the Act creating this chapter.

4 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under  
5 Section 8330.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have  
6 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or  
7 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that  
8 expire on the earlier of:

9 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under  
10 Section 8330.003; or

11 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the  
12 appointment or reappointment.

13 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a  
14 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district  
15 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the  
16 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five  
17 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as  
18 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the  
19 petition.

20 [Sections 8330.053-8330.100 reserved for expansion]

21 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

22 Sec. 8330.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has  
23 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for  
24 which the district is created.

25 Sec. 8330.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND  
26 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the  
27 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,

1 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,  
2 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

3 Sec. 8330.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. (a) Under  
4 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may  
5 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, and  
6 convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for operation and  
7 maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads described by  
8 Section 54.234, Water Code, or improvements, including storm  
9 drainage, in aid of those roads.

10 (b) The district may exercise the powers provided by this  
11 section without submitting a petition to or obtaining approval from  
12 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by  
13 Section 54.234, Water Code.

14 Sec. 8330.104. APPROVAL OF ROAD PROJECT. (a) The district  
15 may not undertake a road project authorized by Section 8330.103  
16 unless:

17 (1) each municipality or county that will operate and  
18 maintain the road has approved the plans and specifications of the  
19 road project, if a municipality or county will operate and maintain  
20 the road; or

21 (2) the Texas Transportation Commission has approved  
22 the plans and specifications of the road project, if the state will  
23 operate and maintain the road.

24 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (a), the district is  
25 not required to obtain approval from the Texas Transportation  
26 Commission to design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for,  
27 improve, or convey a road project.

1       Sec. 8330.105. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. The  
2 district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the  
3 district to acquire a site or easement for:

4               (1) a road project authorized by Section 8330.103; or

5               (2) a recreational facility as defined by Section  
6 49.462, Water Code.

7               [Sections 8330.106-8330.150 reserved for expansion]

8               SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

9       Sec. 8330.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS.

10 (a) The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other  
11 obligations secured by:

12               (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or

13               (2) contract payments described by Section 8330.153.

14       (b) The district must hold an election in the manner  
15 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval  
16 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds  
17 payable from ad valorem taxes.

18       (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem  
19 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a  
20 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an  
21 election held for that purpose.

22       Sec. 8330.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If  
23 authorized at an election held under Section 8330.151, the district  
24 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in  
25 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.

26       (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not  
27 exceed the rate approved at the election.

1       Sec. 8330.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with  
2 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than  
3 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from  
4 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of  
5 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters  
6 voting at an election held for that purpose.

7       (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a  
8 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by  
9 the board without further voter approval.

10       [Sections 8330.154-8330.200 reserved for expansion]

11       SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

12       Sec. 8330.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER  
13 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations  
14 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,  
15 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any  
16 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district  
17 purpose.

18       Sec. 8330.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district  
19 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the  
20 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing  
21 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all  
22 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner  
23 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

24       Sec. 8330.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of  
25 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations  
26 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad  
27 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the

1 real property in the district.

2 SECTION 2. The Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District  
3 No. 192 initially includes all the territory contained in the  
4 following area:

5 TRACT I

6 Being a 37.73-acre (1,643,604 square feet) tract of land  
7 situated in the Abner Kuykendall League, A-48, Fort Bend County,  
8 Texas, and being portion of a called 53.9470-acre tract of land  
9 designated Tract "A" as recorded under File Number 9725698, Fort  
10 Bend County Official Records (F.B.C.O.R.). Said 37.73-acre tract  
11 of land being more particularly described by metes and bounds as

21 centerline of Macek Road (60 feet wide);

22           THENCE, South 68°11'55" East, along the centerline of said  
23 Macek Road, a distance of 268.46 feet to a p.k. nail set for corner;

24           THENCE, South 68°02'25" East, along the centerline of said  
25 Macek Road and along the southerly line of a called 8.6445 acre  
26 tract as recorded under File Number 9707473 of said F.B.C.O.R.,  
27 passing at 579.12 feet a 5/8-inch iron rod with cap stamped

1 "Kalkomey Surveying" found for the southeast corner of said 8.6445  
2 acre tract, being the southwest corner of a called 0.50 acre tract

27 representatives within the required time.

1           (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
2 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
3 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
4 and accomplished.

5           SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
