WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas is proud to welcome members of the Texas Organization of Rural and Community Hospitals, also known as TORCH, and members of the Texas Rural Health Association on their visit to the State Capitol on March 4, 2009; and

WHEREAS, These two organizations work on behalf of the citizens of rural Texas and are dedicated to ensuring that rural Texans have equal access to hospital and health care services as well as timely emergency care; and

WHEREAS, These two organizations consist of the rural hospitals, clinics, health providers, and health professions schools that provide the professional care and the trained workforce for the health care needs of our state's 3.5 million rural citizens; and

WHEREAS, A large part of Texas is rural and medically underserved; there are 177 rural counties, 50 of which do not have a hospital and 99 of which have only one hospital; 112 Texas rural counties have been designated as health professional shortage areas; and


1 health care providers face are critical and complex, and the Texas

13 honor.


