2	WHEREAS, Dr. Robert Bernstein, former commissioner of health

4	committee member of the Texas Health Institute, passed away on July

7	health in Texas, Dr. Bernstein was named commissioner of health in
8	January of 1980 and served with distinction in that capacity until
9	his retirement in June of 1991; with a tenure of 11 and one-half
10	years, he was the longest-serving commissioner of health in Texas;

12	WHEREAS, As head of the department, Dr. Bernstein adeptly
13	addressed the major health problems faced by our state and
14	developed an expansive health program that dealt with education,
15	planning, surveillance, epidemiological study, laboratory
16	analysis, environmental protection, regulation, licensure, and
17	complaint investigation; and
18	WHEREAS, Dr. Bernstein's legacy was a program of broad scope
19	that is still in place and through which today's Department of State
. 20	Health Services can effectively address the needs of our state's
21	citizens and present-day health issues; and
22	WHEREAS, Section 2165.005, Government Code, establishes a
23	procedure for the naming of a state building by requiring that the
24	proposed designation be submitted to the Texas Facilities

- 2 designation be passed by the legislature and signed by the
- 3 governor; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Bernstein was an esteemed public servant and a
- 5 highly effective administrator who worked tirelessly for the
- 6 betterment of his community, state, and country in both his
- 7 professional and personal life; the renaming of Building G of the
- 8 Department of State Health Services Central Complex in Austin in
- 9 his honor would be an opportunity for all Texans to pay tribute to
- 10 his life and to express appreciation for his many contributions to
- 11 our state; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 81st Legislature of the State of Texas
- 13 hereby approve and authorize the renaming of Building G at the
- 14 Department of State Health Services Central Complex in Austin as
