WHEREAS, The Texas Legislative Council is marking the 60th anniversary of its founding in 2009; and

WHEREAS, Created by statute in 1949, the council was 4 established to gather information for the use of the legislature 5 and to assist in drafting legislation; the agency operates under 6 the guidance of a 14-member governing body composed of the 7 lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house, who serve as joint 8 chairs, together with the chair of the house administration 9 committee, five other state representatives, and six senators; the 10 agency's executive director oversees the council staff, which is 11 administration, document organized into six major divisions: 12 production, information systems, legal, policy and planning, and 13 research; and 14

WHEREAS, Through the years, the council has continued to 15 evolve to meet the needs of the legislative branch; today, its staff 16 conducts research, drafts legislation, provides computer services, 17 offers technical support for redistricting, produces publications, 18 reports, and maps, and maintains a number of public and legislative 19 websites; moreover, the council is responsible for the engrossing 20 and enrolling of house bills and resolutions and for the 21 distribution of all house documents; additionally, since 1963 the 22 council has been charged with operating a permanent statutory 23 revision program that involves reorganizing the statutes in topical 24

- 1 codes, eliminating invalid, duplicative, and other ineffective
- 2 provisions, and improving the draftsmanship of the law if
- 3 practicable, and thus far, 25 codes have been adopted; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Over the course of its history, the Texas
- 5 Legislative Council has remained a nonpartisan, professional
- 6 organization committed to the highest standards of public service,
- 7 and it is indeed fitting that the agency be recognized for its
- 8 immeasurable contributions to the Lone Star State; now, therefore,

- 11 hereby commemorate the 60th anniversary of the creation of the
- 12 Texas Legislative Council and extend to the council and its staff
