## Introduction

A study reveals that 281 public libraries listed with the Texas State Library, serve 6,466,502 Texans, or 84% of the State's total 1950 census population of 7,711,194. Of these, approximately 200 submitted reports which form the framework of this directory.

The following summary of 1957 library statistics emphasizes the level of public financial support. Because the county provides the broadest base for public library service in Texas and because future library development seemingly depends upon the extent of this type of financial support, particular attention is focused on this area .

The County Library Law stipulates that a maximum of 10c per \$100 of a county's tax valuation *might* be spent on library service, this amount to come either from the General Fund or the Permanent Improvement Fund. According to the 1958 Texas *Almanac*, the total tax valuation of the state is \$8,724,388,551, which means that \$8,724,389 *could* be invested in libraries.

In reality, 91 counties, with a tax valuation of \$6,682,980,846, spent \$1,000,712, or approximately 15% of what could be spent, and 12½% of the amount which the law permits (these percentages approach the percentage of Texans without public library service—16⅔%). Of the remaining 193 counties, four—Gaines, Scurry, Terry, and Yoakum—established

county libraries in 1957; 60, whose public libraries *did* report, do not appropriate funds for library service; the public libraries in 47 counties *did not* report thus making it impossible to determine whether or not these counties appropriate funds for libraries. The number of counties without public library service stands at 52, with 404,848 Texans, or 35% of those without library service, residing in these counties.

The total income of the reporting libraries was \$4,797,999, of which \$4,390,858 was from city and county governments. This represents a per capita expenditure of \$0.62 for the total population, and \$0.74 for the population served.

Book stock and circulation figures, admittedly incomplete, indicate that 4,717,467 books circulated 14,092,618 times, or approximately three times per book.

There are 115 stations, 115 branches, and 38 bookmobiles.
