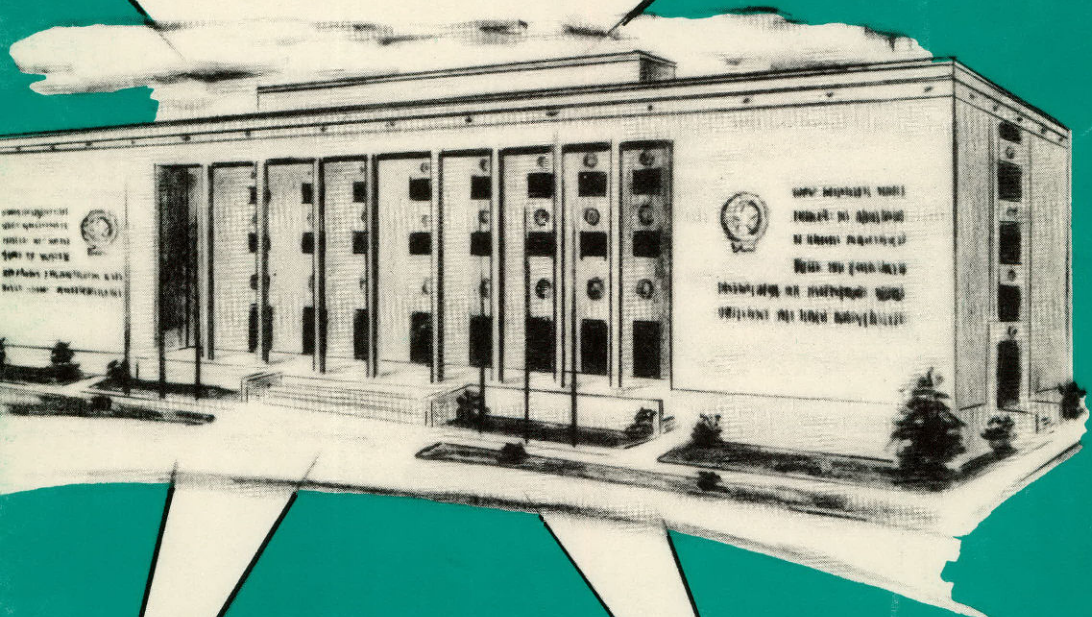

INTRODUCTION

Analysis of 1961 public library reports reveals that 302 libraries serve 8,660,799 Texans, or 90.4% of the State's total 1960 census population of 9,579,677. Of these, 200 submitted reports which form the framework of this directory.

The Texas County Library Law provides that a maximum of 12¢ per \$100 tax valuation of a county may be spent on library service, this amount from either the General Fund or the Permanent Improvement Fund. According to the State Comptroller of Public Accounts, the total tax valuation of the State for 1961 is \$13,317,390,279, which means that \$15,980,686 could be invested in libraries. If this full amount was spent for country library service, it would represent an expenditure of \$1.67 per capita for the total population of Texas.

In reality, 95 counties with a tax valuation of \$7,870,304,658 spent \$1,266,570 or 7.9% of what could be spent according to the limit established by the county library law. Of the remaining 159 counties, 103 whose public libraries did report, do not appropriate county funds for library service; the public libraries in 56 counties did not report this making it impossible to determine whether or not these counties appropriate funds for libraries.

There are 918,868 Texans, or 9.6% of the State's total 1960 population without public library service. Of this total, 33.8%, or 310,836 Texans reside in the 44 counties that do not have public library service.

The total income of the reporting libraries was \$6,758,190 of which \$6,139,923 was from the city and county governments. This represents a per capita of \$0.71 for the total population and \$0.78 for the population served.

Book stock and circulation figures taken from the reports submitted indicate that there are 5,588,454 books available in the public libraries, which is per capita of .58 volumes for the total population. These volumes were circulated 18, 917,803 or approximately 3 1/3 times per book, resulting in a circulation per capita of 1.97 volumes for the total population.

There are 1,531,922 registered borrowers, which is 16% of the total population and 17.7% of the population served.

Of the reporting libraries, data show there are 117 stations, 106 branches, and 41 bookmobiles in Texas. The Texas State Library has five (5) bookmobiles operating in multi-county areas of Texas as one of the projects for the further extension of library services in the rural areas authorized by the Library Services Act of 1956 and amended in 1960.

* Population figures for towns having libraries have been subtracted from total county population figure.

** The three libraries of Kilgore, Longview and Gladewater rotate the headship of the county library each year. For this report, Kilgore is given the county population figure less those of the other two towns. The report from the librarian at Kilgore serves as the basis for the information on the county funds available in Gregg County for libraries.
