

PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE IN TEXAS

Of the 252 public libraries in Texas listed with the Texas State Library, 192 filed reports in time to be included in this publication. The 252 public libraries in Texas may be classified as

- 142 city and town libraries
- 79 county libraries
- 1 bi-county library
- 30 city-county libraries.

Only 24 of the 60 libraries which did not send in reports in time to be included in this compilation serve populations of more than 3,000. While their presence in the statistics would increase the service figures, the increase would not be substantial.

In this discussion only libraries which receive most of their income from the tax funds of governmental units and which are available for free use to all the citizens are included in the term "public libraries." While this, admittedly, omits many libraries which are essentially public in service, it is a restriction necessary to the determination of the tax support of public library service in Texas. Although club libraries and other libraries which are supported primarily by private contribution are omitted in this introductory summary, they are included in the directory under "public libraries." There are 28 libraries, not included in the 252 public libraries classified above, reporting to the State Library for 1955, which received no tax support but which

are available for use by the general populace of their communities.

The four classifications above are defined as follows for the purpose of this discussion:

City and town libraries: Libraries receiving their support from the local municipal government and offering their services to citizens of the community. If the citizens of the county who live outside the municipality are allowed to use libraries in this category, it is by informal agreement and not through contractual or other formal financial arrangement with the county government.

County libraries: Libraries receiving their support from the local county government and extending their services to all the citizens of the county, though not necessarily through library extension units such as branches, deposit stations, or bookmobiles.

Bi-county library: Library receiving its support from two adjoining counties and extending its services to the citizens of both counties on an equal basis. At present there is only one such library in Texas, the Hutchinson-Carson counties library.

City-county libraries: Libraries receiving their support from a municipal government with supplementary funds from the county for the provision of library service to county residents under a contractual relationship or by direct appropriation of county money to the library.

In 1955 the estimated total Texas population was 8,657,000. According to reports received by the State Library, 7,639,627 or 88.25 percent of the state population have some kind of library service available to them. This leaves 1,017,730 Texans, or 11.75 percent of the state population without library service.

Of the 7,639,627 people in Texas with library service available to them, 1,087,380 or 14.23 percent were reported by libraries as registered library users. The number registered represents 12.56 percent of the total population of the state. In 1955 they borrowed, according to the reports, 12,495,777 books from public libraries. This averages approximately 11.5 books per capita for registered borrowers and 1.44 books per capita for the total state population. The total reported circulation indicates an increase of 1,407,809 or approximately 12.7 percent in 1955 over the total circulation reported for 1954.

The reports indicate that public libraries in Texas own a total of 4,387,260, or 0.51 books per capita for the total state population and 4.04 books per capita for registered borrowers.

The total income for 1955 reported by Texas libraries was \$3,647,984 or approximately 42.1 cents per capita for the total state population and 58.3 cents per capita of the total population served by the public libraries which reported 1955 income. The total in-

come reported for 1955 represents an increase of \$29,193 over the reported income for 1954 but a decrease in income per capita for the total state population of 1.3 cents, from 43.4 cents per capita in 1954 to 42.1 cents per capita in 1955, and a decrease of 10.2 cents per capita for the population served by the libraries which reported their incomes for 1954 and 1955.

For 1955 Texas public libraries reported a total of 260 extension units: 117 branches, 110 deposit stations, and 33 bookmobiles. Compared to 1954 this is an increase of six branches, a decrease of 17 deposit stations, and an increase of two bookmobiles.

The following directory is divided into these categories: Public Libraries, 1955; College and University Libraries, 1955; Special Libraries, 1955; Counties with Library Service; Counties with No Library Service; and Head Librarians. Under Public Libraries, 1955 we have included the city in which located, the name of the library, the librarian, the estimated 1955 population served, registration, circulation, book stock, total income for 1955, the number of full-time staff members, hours open weekly, and the number and kinds of extension units.

Since these statistics were taken from reports received by the State Library from the libraries themselves, this Directory can be only as accurate as the reports received were accurate.
