## PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE IN TEXAS

Of the 276 public libraries in Texas listed with the Texas State Library, 227 filed reports in time to be included in this publication. Of these, 193 libraries which indicated they received some kind of financial support from governmental units may be classified as:

### Bi-county library (1)

Library receiving its support from two adjoining counties and extending its service to the citizens of both counties on an equal basis. At present there is only one such library in Texas, the Hutchinson-Carson Regional Library.

### County libraries (49)

Libraries receiving their support from the local county government and extending their services to all the citizens of the county, though not necessarily through library extension units such branches, deposit stations, or bookmobiles.

### County-city libraries (68)

Libraries receiving their support from a municipal government with supplementary funds from the county for the provision of library service to county residents under a contractual relationship or by direct appropriation of county money to the library.

### City and town libraries (75)

Libraries receiving their support from the local municipal government and offering their services to citizens of the community.

The Directory is limited to public libraries. This year the special, college and university libraries are omitted, but a list will appear in the May issue of *Texas Libraries*.

The 1957 Directory is divided into the following categories: Public Libraries (Town, City and County), 1956—arranged by population according to 1950 Census figures, but with the latest population figures from the 1956-1957 *Texas Almanac*; Library Service by Counties—with the cities and towns where library service is available *according to information received by the Texas State Library*; and Head Librarians.

The public library statistics include: the town or city in which the library is located; the name of the library; population served; total income; public funds (city and county); the number of full-time staff

members; hours open weekly; and the number and kind of extension units.

A county population figure in bold face type indicates the library reported that it served the entire county. The adequacy of this service can be determined by examining the statistics the library submitted. If a city library reported that it performed this function, i.e., served the entire county, the city population is also listed. When a county library reported its service excluded certain cities, the county figure in bold face type with an asterisk is the total county population less the population of these cities. A "dash" (—) in the county column means that a library, according to its report, extends its service to an undetermined part of the county.

If a governmental unit was reported as paying the library expenses, and the amount of such expenses were indicated, these were considered as public funds. When the report indicated city or county support, but not the exact amount, a "dash" (—) is in the appropriate column. Figures in parentheses arrived too late to be included in the totals on the chart above.
