Rec Passes

All drop-in customers, ages 8+, must show their rec pass and have a current liability waiver on file. The rec pass is scanned for facility use and is valid for one year from the date of purchase. Fee-based activities do not require a rec pass. Resident passes cost \$10 per year with a max of \$20 per family, and nonresident passes cost \$15 per year with a max of \$40 per family. Replacement cards cost \$2.




