that it is in good condition. Concerning
the Farming House, have you had a new
lease signed so that the furniture is responsible
for the rent. And so has you have the
power to put him out if he does not pay
promptly. If he did not pay any back
rent, the New should certainly be payable
in advance, after having had twelve months
use of the property he certainly could afford
to do that. And the improvements, if he desires
them made he certainly can not object to
pay for them out of the amount he owes.
It is tolerable tight papers to sent your
House for nothing, and keep it in repair

Box 54 and I shall desire to get them,
had not you better get some warrants
from Robinson and try and work them off
I have not much faith in the fidelity
of them or the Bonds. Let Murray make
contracts for repairs under your supervision
payable out of amount due on rent
for 1864. And the enclosed drift to Mr. Nichols,
do not forget it as it is important and delay
dangerous. Also say to him that he will note
drift was paid.
