KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:-

THAT John Taylor having served faithfully and honorably for the term of nine months from the Fourteenth day of February 1837 until the Fifth day of December 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to nine hundred and sixty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said John Taylor is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.
