We have just received the Saddles you carried to Houston to sell for us. We sent you 55 Saddles and we have received 51 - four fine Saddles missing - M^r Mussett, made returns for two sold - and two is yet missing - The two packages of Blankets - one hundred in number - are still at Wm M. Rice's, where you left them -

You will please let dispose of them for Cotton or a permit to export Cotton if you can -

They cost us \$11 - a pair last fall - and you will sell them for the best price you can
