

Est. of Peter Froze } It appearing to the satisfaction of the
_____ } Court, by the Statements of the Clerk
of Probate, that due notice has been given for twenty days
preceeding the meeting of this Court, in terms of the laws
of the application of John St. Brown Admr. of this Estate
for a discharge; and of the intention of the Heirs to
apply at the presents term for a decree of all property
remaining to the Estate to them, and no one appearing
to contest the same, full and complete proof having
been exhibited & filed in Court, of the tenorship, which by
the Court, is deemed good and sufficient in law. And
Theodore Froze having filed in Court Letters of atty.
from all the heirs of the Estate of Peter Froze dec.
authorizing him to act for them in the settlements
of this Estate. Upon a full consideration of said
petitions, and documents submitted, It is considered, Or-
dered and adjudged by the Court, That all the property
real and personal at present belonging to the Estate
and remaining unexpended be divided into two e-
qual portions, one half of which shall go and belong
to Samuel Froze the father of decedent, And it ap-
pearing to the Court, that the Mother of said Peter
Froze is not living, The other half of the Estate of
decedent is adjudge to go & belong to the following
named heirs in proportions as follows - That is to say
The remaining half of the Estate shall be divided into
fifteen Equal Shares & delivered to the Heirs, to wit. One
share each to Alonzo & Job Froze, Children of Morris &
Sarah Froze, The said Morris having been own brother to
decedent and is now dead. Two Shares to Hannah Gonyer
wife of Isaac Gonyer. Two Shares to Abigail Speyey wife
of John Speyey, Two Shares to Phebe Clarkson wife
of Alex^r Clarkson. The said Abigail, Hannah & Phebe

being the sisters of decedent. And one share each to Lewis
Mary, Sarah Lane, W. Henry & Theodore Kroeze, they being
half brothers & sisters of decedent, and all of the foregoing
heirs being at present residents of the State of New Jersey
one of the United States of North America, And that all
the property real and personal, at present belonging to
the Estate of Peter Kroeze dec'd be and the same is hereby
decreed & adjudged to the Heirs, herein enumerated, in
the proportion herein enumerated, by as full good and
perfect a right and title as the decedent Peter Kroeze
had at or after the time of his death; And that the
Adm'r John W. Brown deliver the same to Theodore Kroeze
the agent and Attorney in fact of said Heirs. And it ap-
pearing by the petition of Theodore Kroeze as atty aforesaid
that the adm'r has fully settled with him for all moneys
rec'd rights, credits &c. And by the representations of the
Adm'r John W. Brown, that he has paid all debts & claims
against this Estate no one appearing to contest his applica-
tion for a discharge from the Administration. It is
considered by the Court that upon his (the said John
W. Brown as adm'r) delivering all the property real
& personal, now remaining in his hands as adm'r
that he be forever released from all responsibility on
his bond of adm'r & go hence discharged, together
with his securities. And it is further decreed & adju-
dged that the proofs of heirship upon which this
decree is founded, together with the letters of attorney
from the above named heirs to Theodore Kroeze be
recorded, as part of the proceedings in this Court
upon which they may be withdrawn by the agents
aforesaid, and the Estate decreed finally closed
upon payment of costs, by John W. Brown adm'r

The conditions of the above decree were immediately
complied with in open court by the admsr & he is
therefore hereby dismissed from further admsnⁿ—
