portion of the above mentioned amount of Eight Thousand
Three Hundred and Thirty seven $\frac{5}{100}$ Dollars. I agree that
they may retain say twenty Bonds of one thousand Dollars
each of the Houston and Texas Central Rail Road Company,
issued by said Rail Road Company upon my contract for
building Thirtynine and one half miles of Rail Road and
issued under date of July 1st 1859 to Wm M. Rice and
David St. Paige Trustees and the said Wm M. Rice & Co are
authorized to sell the said Bonds to the best advantage at
public or private sale in time to meet the above mentioned
drafts made on them by me unless the payment is otherwise
provided for, before their maturity.
