On their way to Louisiana on October 23rd, 1999, Candelario and San Juanita Garcia and his mother, Stella, all of Victoria, stopped in Baytown to get gas, never thinking that a clerk's mistake would make them millionaires.

They were thinking only of celebrating the younger Mrs. Garcia's birthday, which was on the 23rd.

With their \$20 in winnings from the previous night's *Texas Million* drawing, the Garcias purchased \$10 worth of *Lotto Texas* tickets each at the Chevron located at 5027 I-10 and Garth.

"The clerk made a mistake when I asked for a Lotto ticket," San Juanita said.

"She gave me 10 annuity *Quick Pick* tickets instead of the Cash Value Option I planned to get. So my husband got 10 Cash Value Option *Quick Picks* and I got another 10, but under the annuity plan."


Mr. Garcia says they took the errant tickets because, "I remembered that once someone had won the *Lotto* with a 'mistake' ticket."

The winners received an initial payment of \$1,664,858. There will be 24 additional installment payments of \$1,520,000 each, payable on October 15th each year. The total payout after 25 years will be \$38,144,858.

The winning numbers were 16-10-31-40-12-14. For selling a winning Lotto Texas jackpot ticket, the Chevron store is eligible to receive a one-percent jackpot bonus of \$381,448.58.
