14	who fails to timely submit a claim for payment to the insurance
15	carrier under Section 408.027(a) does not forfeit the provider's
16	right to reimbursement for that claim for payment solely for
17	failure to submit a timely claim if:
18	(1) the provider submits proof satisfactory to the
19	commissioner that the provider, within the period prescribed by
20	Section 408.027(a), erroneously filed for reimbursement with:
21	(A) an insurer that issues a policy of group
22	accident and health insurance under which the injured employee is a
23	covered insured;
24	(B) a health maintenance organization that

- 3 (C) a workers' compensation insurance carrier

- (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a health care provider
- who erroneously submits a claim for payment to an entity described
- 11 by Subdivision (1) of that subsection forfeits the provider's right
- 12 to reimbursement for that claim if the provider fails to submit the
- claim to the correct workers' compensation insurance carrier within
- 14 95 days after the date the provider is notified of the provider's
- 15 erroneous submission of the claim.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or
- 17 Section 408.027, the period for submitting a claim for payment may
- 18 be extended by agreement of the parties.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 408.0272, Labor Code, as added by this
- 20 Act, applies to a claim for payment relating to health care services
- 21 rendered on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim for
- 22 payment relating to health care services rendered before the
- 23 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 24 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
