

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the delivery of voter registration certificates.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 13.144(a), Election Code, is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (a) Not later than the 30th day after the date the registrar
7 receives the application, the [~~The~~] registrar shall deliver the
8 original of an initial certificate:

9 (1) in person to the applicant or the applicant's agent
10 appointed under Section 13.003; or

11 (2) by mail to the applicant.

12 SECTION 2. Section 15.004(b), Election Code, is amended to
13 read as follows:

14 (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date the registrar
15 receives [~~On receipt of~~] the notice, the registrar shall deliver to
16 the voter a replacement certificate containing:

17 (1) the registration number and other information on
18 the lost or destroyed certificate; and

19 (2) a notation that the certificate is a replacement.

20 SECTION 3. Section 15.024(a), Election Code, is amended to
21 read as follows:

22 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), after correcting
23 the registration records with respect to a voter, if necessary, the
24 registrar shall [~~promptly~~] issue the voter a registration

1 certificate containing the appropriate corrections and deliver it
2 to the voter not later than the 30th day after the date the
3 registrar receives notice of a correction.

4 SECTION 4. Section 13.144(c), Election Code, is repealed.

5 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
6 to a voter registration certificate for which an application,
7 notice of loss or destruction, or notice of a correction is received
8 by the voter registrar on or after September 1, 2007.

9 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.


