

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the confidentiality of certain home address information
3 in local tax appraisal records regarding current or former peace
4 officers and regarding a current or former employee of a
5 prosecutor's office or of certain offices with jurisdiction over
6 child protective services matters.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Section 25.025(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
9 as follows:

10 (a) This section applies only to:

11 (1) a current or former peace officer as defined by
12 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure;

13 (2) a county jailer as defined by Section 1701.001,
14 Occupations Code;

15 (3) an employee of the Texas Department of Criminal
16 Justice;

17 (4) a commissioned security officer as defined by
18 Section 1702.002, Occupations Code; ~~and~~

19 (5) a victim of family violence as defined by Section
20 71.004, Family Code, if as a result of the act of family violence
21 against the victim, the actor is convicted of a felony or a Class A
22 misdemeanor; and

23 (6) a current or former employee of a district
24 attorney, criminal district attorney, or county or municipal

1 attorney whose jurisdiction includes any criminal law or child
2 protective services matters.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
