

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the name of Sam Houston State University.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 96.61, Education Code, is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 96.61. SAM HOUSTON STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) Sam Houston
7 State University is a coeducational institution of higher education
8 located in the city of Huntsville. It is under the management and
9 control of the Board of Regents, Texas State University System.

10 (b) The board may not change the name of the university.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
