

1 AN ACT

2 relating to certain security technology at unmanned teller
3 machines.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 59.310, Finance Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

7 (b-1) The rules may provide for a system that enhances
8 customer security, taking into account emerging technologies, the
9 availability of networks to exchange information, and the potential
10 compliance costs for financial institutions and other unmanned
11 teller machine service providers.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
