

1 AN ACT

2 relating to an inspection performed by a plumbing inspector or
3 qualified plumbing inspection business for a political
4 subdivision.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 1301.255(e), Occupations Code, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 (e) Plumbing installed in compliance with a code adopted
9 under Subsection (a), (b), or (d) must be inspected by a plumbing
10 inspector. To perform the inspection, the political subdivision
11 may contract with any plumbing inspector or qualified plumbing
12 inspection business, as determined by the political subdivision,
13 that is paid directly by the political subdivision.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
