

1 AN ACT

2 relating to eligibility for a municipal setting designation related
3 to potential impacts to groundwater quality of solid waste
4 activities.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 361.803, Health and Safety Code, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 361.803. ELIGIBILITY FOR A MUNICIPAL SETTING
9 DESIGNATION. A person, including a local government, may submit a
10 request to the executive director for a municipal setting
11 designation for property if:

12 (1) the property is within the corporate limits or
13 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality authorized by
14 statute [~~that has a population of at least 20,000~~]; and

15 (2) a public drinking water supply system exists that
16 satisfies the requirements of Chapter 341 and that supplies or is
17 capable of supplying drinking water to:

18 (A) the property for which designation is sought;
19 and

20 (B) property within one-half mile of the property
21 for which designation is sought.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
