

1 AN ACT

2 relating to revenue from Texas State Rifle Association specialty
3 license plates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 504.631(b), Transportation Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b) After deduction of the department's administrative
8 costs, the remainder of the fee shall be deposited to the credit of
9 an account in the general revenue fund that may be appropriated only
10 to the Texas Cooperative Extension of The Texas A&M University
11 System as follows:

12 (1) 50 percent to supplement existing and future
13 scholarship programs supported by the Texas State Rifle
14 Association; and

15 (2) 50 percent to support the [~~to provide grants to~~
16 4-H Shooting Sports Program for youth [~~Club shooting sports~~
17 ~~programs to promote safety education~~].

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
