

AN ACT

relating to the confirmation election of the Duval County Groundwater Conservation District.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 8808.003, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8808.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation election held before September 1, 2009 [~~2007~~]:

(1) the district is dissolved on September 1, 2009 [~~2007~~], except that:

(A) any debts incurred shall be paid;

(B) any assets that remain after the payment of debts shall be transferred to Duval County; and

(C) the organization of the district shall be maintained until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and

(2) this chapter expires on September 1, 2012 [~~2010~~].

SECTION 2. Section 8808.023, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

(d) Duval County may pay for any portion of the costs incident to the district's confirmation election.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
