- SECTION 2. Section 46.004(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (c) The commission shall waive the fee for a qualified disabled veteran as defined by Section 42.012 and for a resident on active duty as a member of the United States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard, or the
- 22 <u>Texas</u> State Guard.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
