

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the funds allocation advisory committee of the Texas  
3 Commission on Fire Protection.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 419.054(a), Government Code, is amended  
6 to read as follows:

7 (a) The funds allocation advisory committee is composed of  
8 six members. Two [~~Three~~] members are appointed by the State  
9 Firemen's and Fire Marshals' Association of Texas. Two [~~Three~~]  
10 members are appointed by the Texas State Association of Fire  
11 Fighters. Two members are appointed by the Texas Fire Chiefs  
12 Association. A committee member is subject to removal by the  
13 commission. A vacancy on the committee caused by removal of a  
14 member by the commission shall be filled by the authority that  
15 appointed the member who was removed.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
