

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a school district board of trustees to
3 create a criminal offense for violation of a district policy.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 37.102(c), Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (c) A person who violates [~~this subchapter or~~] any rule
8 adopted under this subchapter providing for the operation and
9 parking of vehicles on school property commits an offense. An
10 offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
