

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.5621(a)(6), Government Code, is 6 7 amended to read as follows: (6) "Corrections officer" means <u>a corrections</u> [an] 8 officer employed by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or a 9 10 juvenile correctional officer employed by the Texas Youth 11 Commission. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
