

1 metal license plate attached to the front or rear of the exterior of
2 the vehicle; and

3 (4) the country in which the person that owns or
4 controls the vehicle is domiciled or is a citizen provides a
5 reciprocal exemption for commercial motor vehicles owned or
6 controlled by residents of this state.

7 (c) Notwithstanding any reciprocity agreement between this
8 state and another state of the United States, a foreign commercial
9 motor vehicle that engages primarily in transportation of cargo
10 across the border into or from a border commercial zone must be:

11 (1) registered in this state; or

12 (2) operated under the exemption provided by this
13 section.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
