2	relating to the administration of international assessment
3	instruments to certain public school students.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 39.037 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 39.037. INTERNATIONAL ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT PROGRAM.
8	(a) In this section, "program" means the international assessment
9	instrument program.
10	(b) The commissioner shall establish a program under which
11	a participating school district administers international
12	assessment instruments to students in the district.

- 13 (c) A school district may apply to the commissioner to 14 participate in the program. The commissioner shall select for
- participation school districts from both rural and urban areas of
- 16 the state. If necessary, the commissioner may require a school
- 17 <u>district to participate in the program.</u>
- 18 <u>(d) A participating school district shall administer</u>
 19 <u>international assessment instruments as required by the</u>
- 20 commissioner.
- (e) In administering the program, the commissioner shall:
- (1) compare the performance on the international
- 23 assessment instruments of students in this state with students of
- 24 the same grade level in other countries;

- 1 (2) compare the international assessment instruments
 2 with state assessment instruments and state educational goals; and
- 3 (3) provide professional development for educators in
- 4 the interpretation and use of results of the international
- 5 assessment instruments.
- 6 (f) Each biennium the commissioner may use funds
 7 appropriated for the Foundation School Program to provide funding
 8 for the program in an amount not to exceed \$2 million.
- 9 (g) Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the
 10 commissioner shall prepare and deliver a report describing the
 11 results of student performance on the international assessment
- 12 instruments to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker
- of the house of representatives, each member of the legislature,
- 14 and each school district.
- (h) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to administer this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
