

AN ACT

relating to an optional fee on registration of a vehicle in certain counties to fund transportation projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 502, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 502.1725 to read as follows:

Sec. 502.1725. OPTIONAL COUNTY FEE FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS. (a) This section applies only to a county:

(1) that borders the United Mexican States;

(2) that has a population of more than 300,000; and

(3) in which the largest municipality has a population of less than 300,000.

(b) The commissioners court of a county by order may impose an additional fee, not to exceed \$10, for registering a vehicle in the county.

(c) A vehicle that may be registered under this chapter without payment of a registration fee may be registered in a county imposing a fee under this section without payment of the additional fee.

(d) A fee imposed under this section may take effect only on January 1 of a year. The county must adopt the order and notify the department not later than September 1 of the year preceding the year in which the fee takes effect.

(e) A fee imposed under this section may be removed. The

1 removal may take effect only on January 1 of a year. A county may  
2 remove the fee only by:

3 (1) rescinding the order imposing the fee; and

4 (2) notifying the department not later than September  
5 1 of the year preceding the year in which the removal takes effect.

6 (f) The county assessor-collector of a county imposing a fee  
7 under this section shall collect the additional fee for a vehicle  
8 when other fees imposed under this chapter are collected. The  
9 county shall send the fee revenue to the regional mobility  
10 authority of the county to fund long-term transportation projects  
11 in the county.

12 (g) The department shall collect the additional fee on a  
13 vehicle that is owned by a resident of a county imposing a fee under  
14 this section and that, under this chapter, must be registered  
15 directly with the department. The department shall send all fees  
16 collected for a county under this subsection to the regional  
17 mobility authority of the county to fund long-term transportation  
18 projects in the county.

19 (h) The department shall adopt rules and develop forms  
20 necessary to administer registration by mail for a vehicle being  
21 registered in a county imposing a fee under this section.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
26 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
