13	(b) The commissioners court of a county by order may impose
14	an additional fee, not to exceed \$10, for registering a vehicle in

16	(c) A vehicle that may be registered under this chapter
17	without payment of a registration fee may be registered in a county
18	imposing a fee under this section without payment of the additional

20	(d) A fee imposed under this section may take effect only on
21	January 1 of a year. The county must adopt the order and notify the
22	department not later than September 1 of the year preceding the year

- 4 (2) notifying the department not later than September

- (f) The county assessor-collector of a county imposing a fee

 under this section shall collect the additional fee for a vehicle

 when other fees imposed under this chapter are collected. The

 county shall send the fee revenue to the regional mobility

 authority of the county to fund long-term transportation projects

 in the county.
 - vehicle that is owned by a resident of a county imposing a fee under this section and that, under this chapter, must be registered directly with the department. The department shall send all fees collected for a county under this subsection to the regional mobility authority of the county to fund long-term transportation projects in the county.
- (h) The department shall adopt rules and develop forms
 necessary to administer registration by mail for a vehicle being
 registered in a county imposing a fee under this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
