Section 370.251(c), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows: 5 <u>Directors</u> [If permitted under the constitution of this 6 7 state, directors serve staggered six-year terms, with the terms of no more than one-third of the directors expiring on February 1 of 8 each-odd-numbered-year. If six-year terms are not permitted under 9 the constitution, directors] serve two-year terms, with as near as 10 possible to [the terms of not more than] one-half of the directors' 11 terms [directors] expiring on February 1 of each year. 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 17
