

1 AN ACT

2 relating to condemnation of historical sites at the direction of
3 the Commission of Control for Texas Centennial Celebrations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 433, Acts of the 44th Legislature, 2nd
6 Called Session, 1935 (Article 3264c, Vernon's Texas Civil
7 Statutes), is repealed.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
12 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
